Important Information Regarding Lincolnton Recycling Program

The City of Lincolnton provides recycling for all residents. Please remember recycling is an economical and environmental alternative to the landfill.

Listed below are reminders regarding Lincolnton's recycling program.

A recycling bin is provided by the City. Before putting recyclables in your bin, always:

1. Remove and throw away all lids and caps
2. Rinse all containers
3. Flatten all plastics

Never put recyclables in plastic or paper bags. If you have an overflow, please use an open box. The box will be left with your container at the curb. Please write the word recycle on the box.

Items That May Be Recycled

***GLASS** – All food jars and beverage bottles

Do not put light bulbs, cookware, mirrors, window (plate) glass, ceramic dishes, drinking glasses, medicine bottles, or broken glass.

***CANS** – All food and beverage cans

Do not put aluminum foil, aluminum pie plates, or any other type of metal.

***PAPER** – All newspaper and inserts, magazines, catalogs, and phone books.

Do not put boxes, mail bags, or other paper

***PLASTIC** – All plastic bottles with the following symbols (plastic bottles are now banned from landfills)



Do not put motor oil or pesticide plastic bottles, regardless of the symbol.
