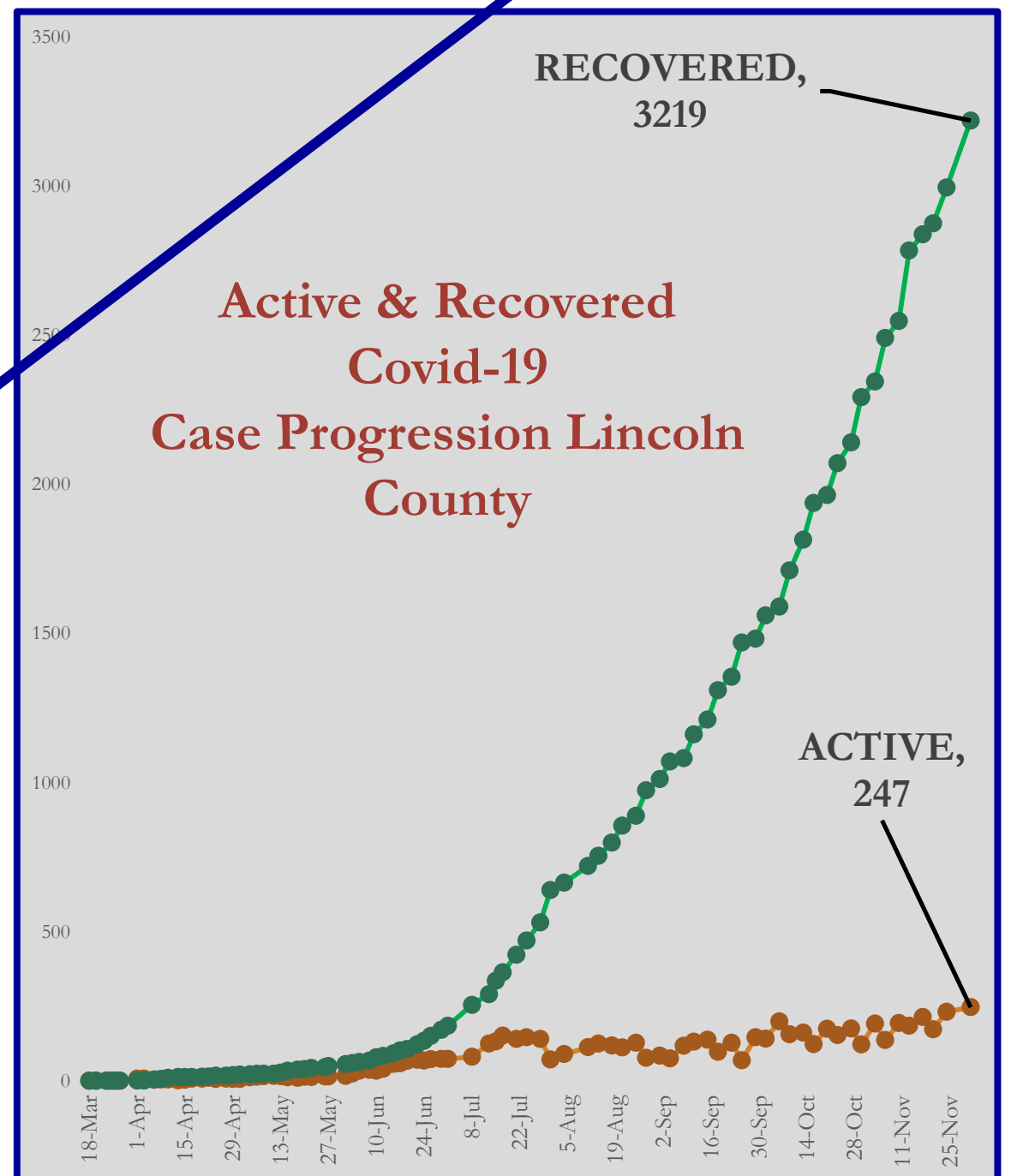
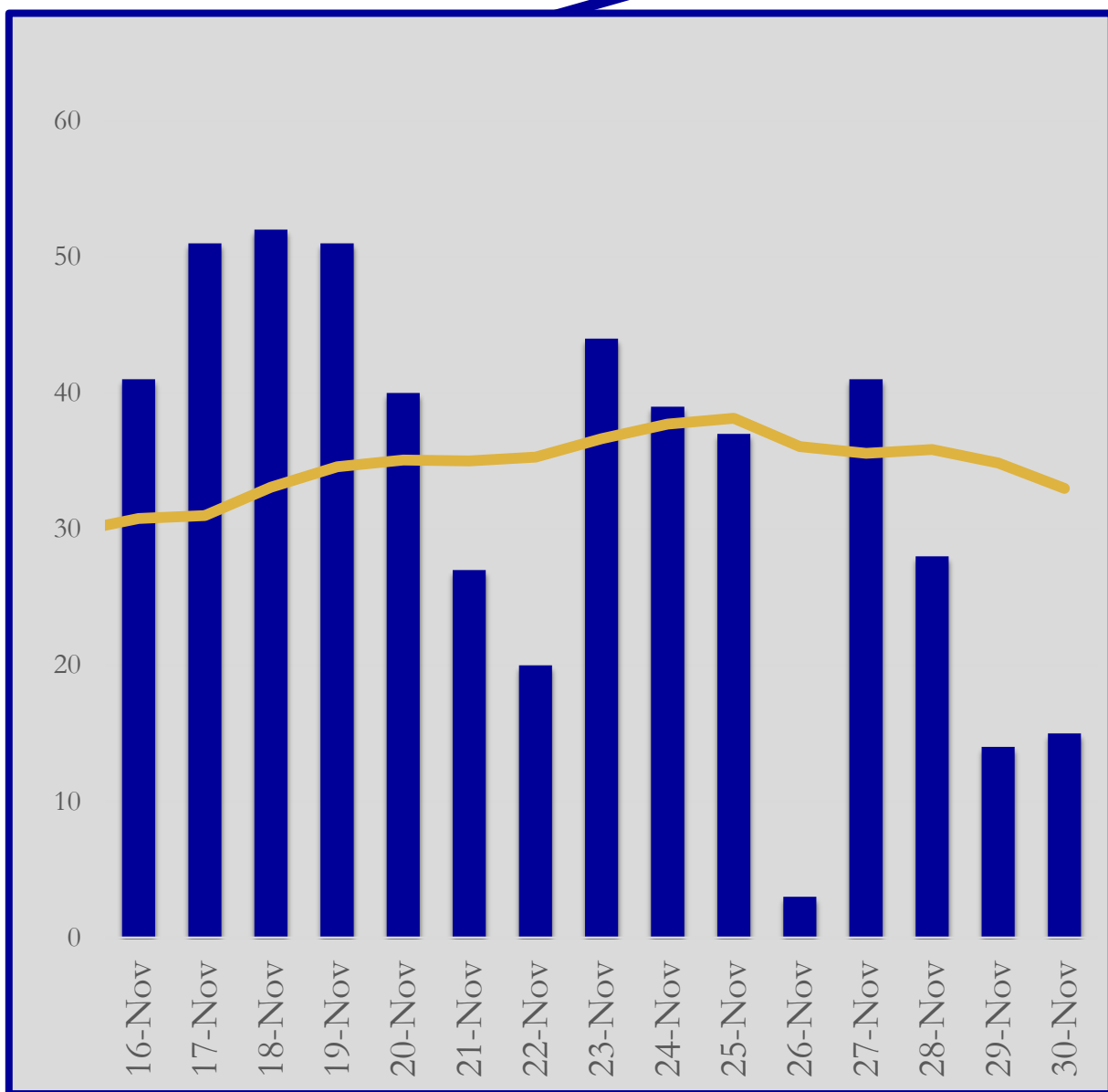
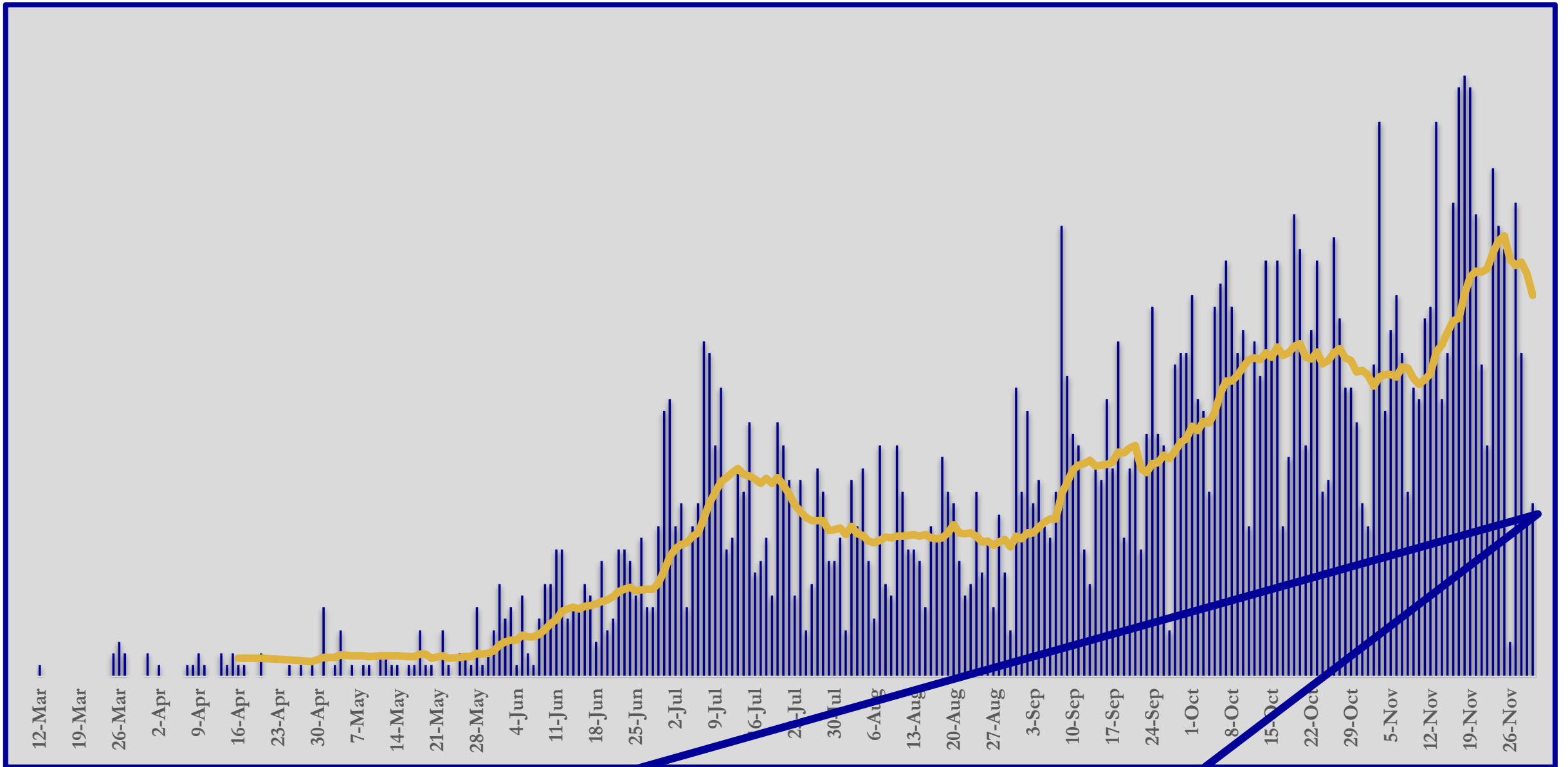

Lincoln County continues to see a high degree of positives for Covid-19. We have averaged slightly more than 30 resulted positives per day for the past 30 days. For the past 30 days, approximately 13.2% of tested positives were between the ages of 0-17. This is an increase in positive cases in this age demographic. The percent of positive cases for the age demographic of 65+ is approximately 16.6%. This is a notable increase in this age demographic from the last report. Our total resulted positives for the past 14 days is approximately 9.8%.



This graph shows case count by test date from November 16th – November 30th.

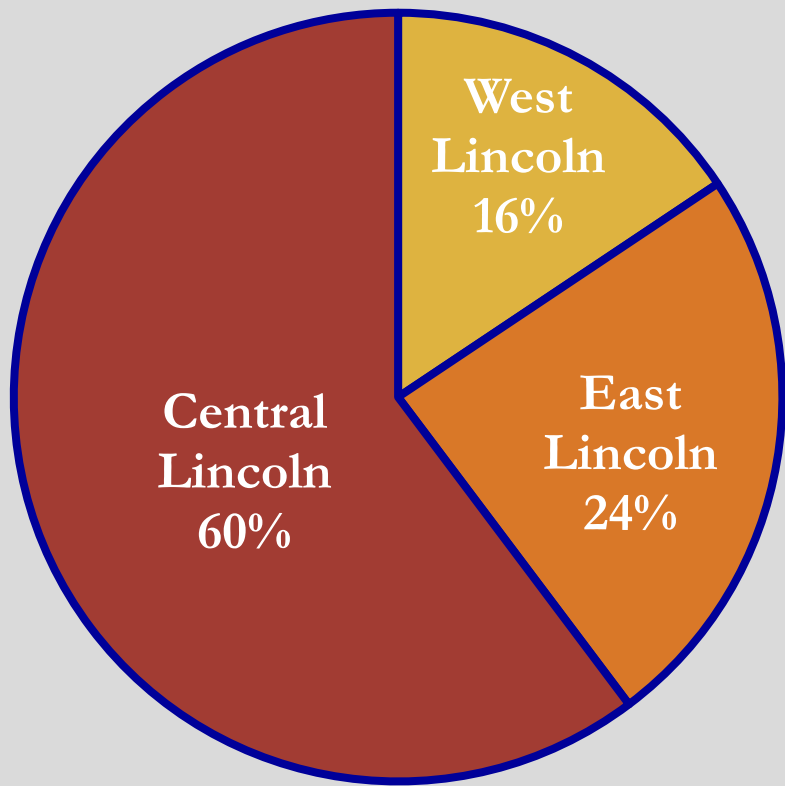

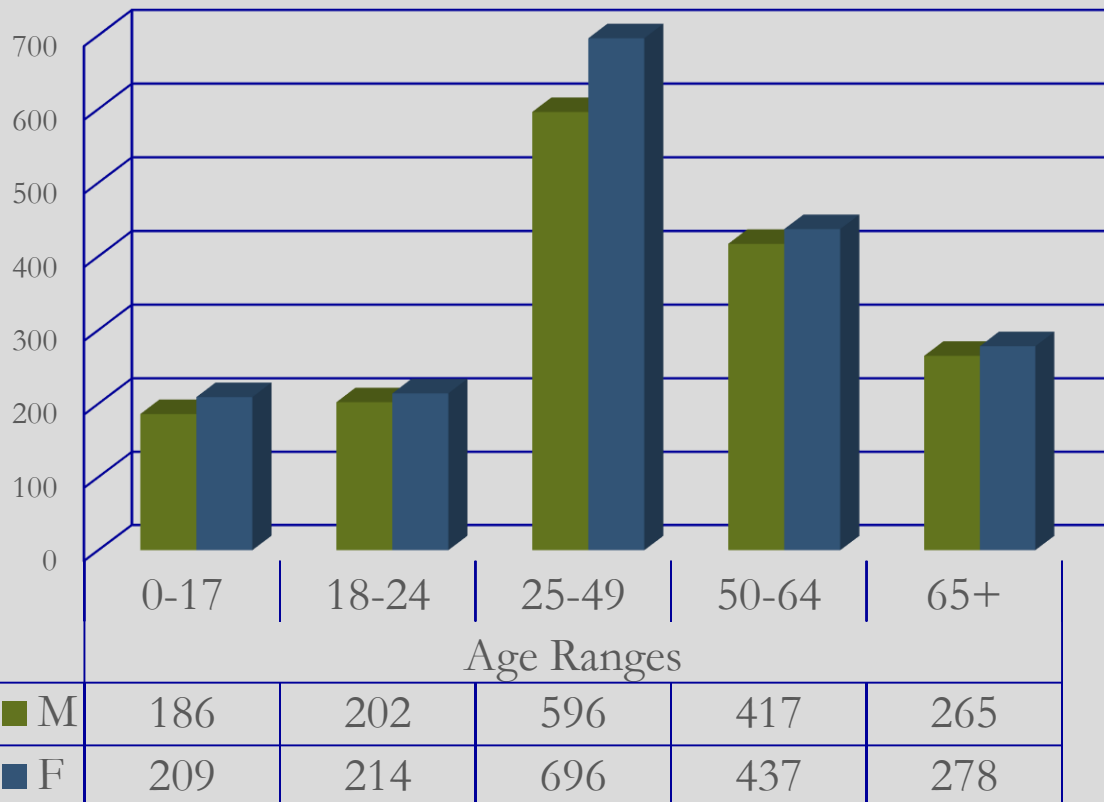

Regional COVID-19 Presence

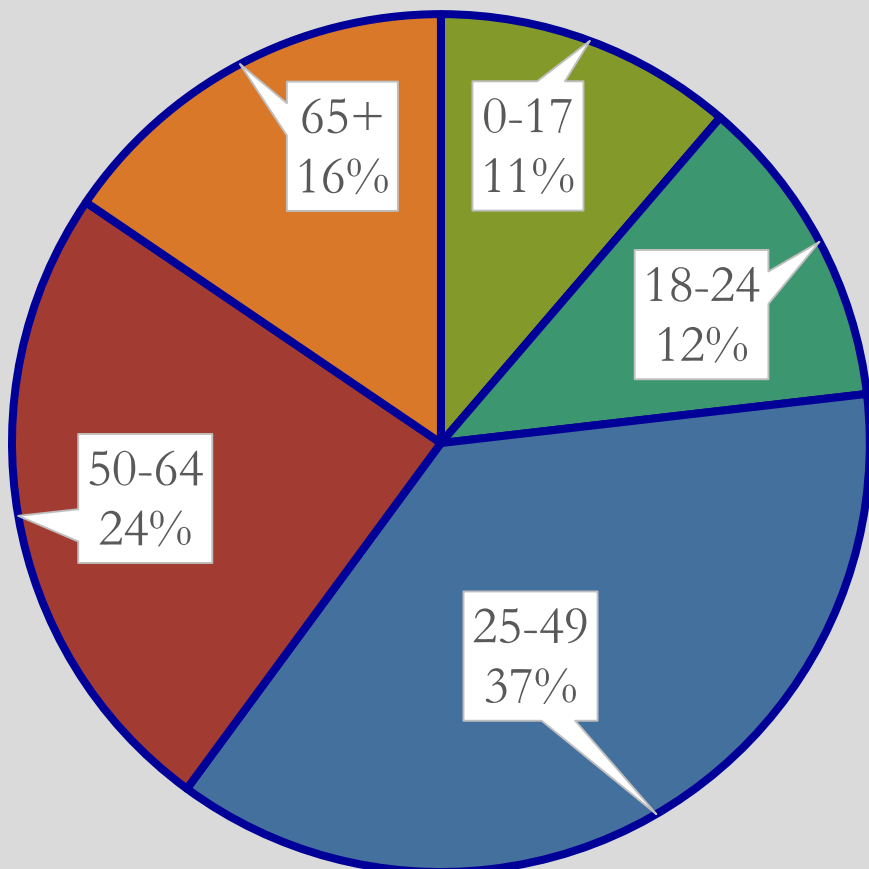
