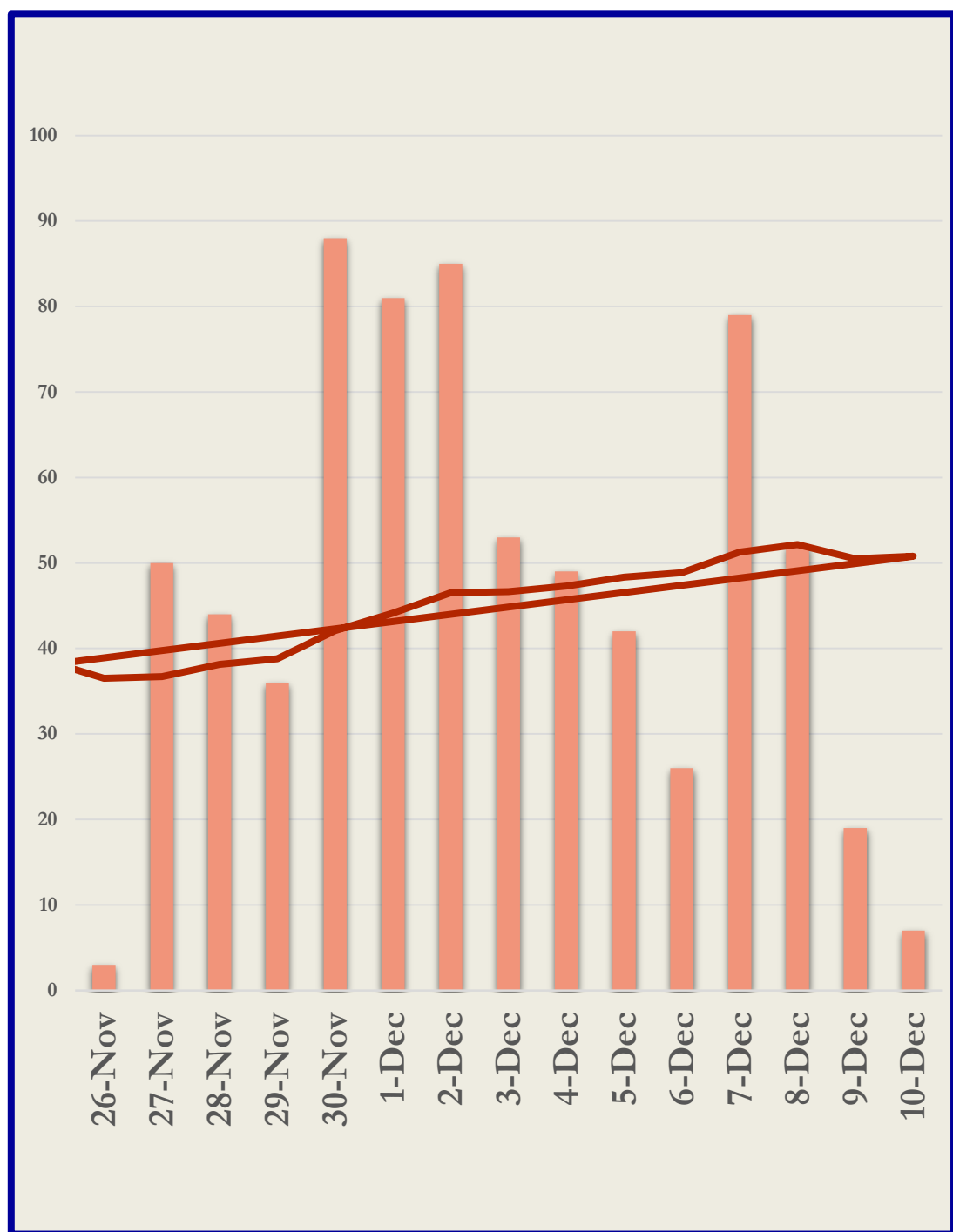
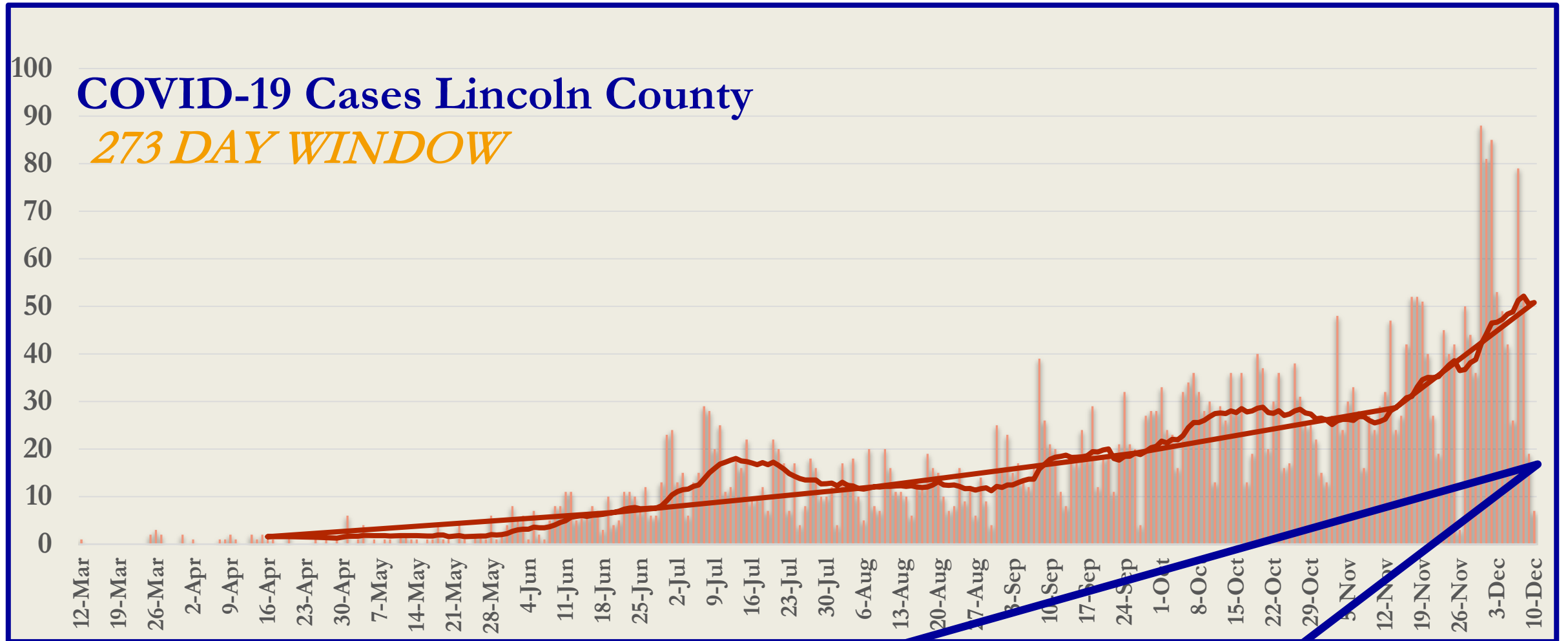


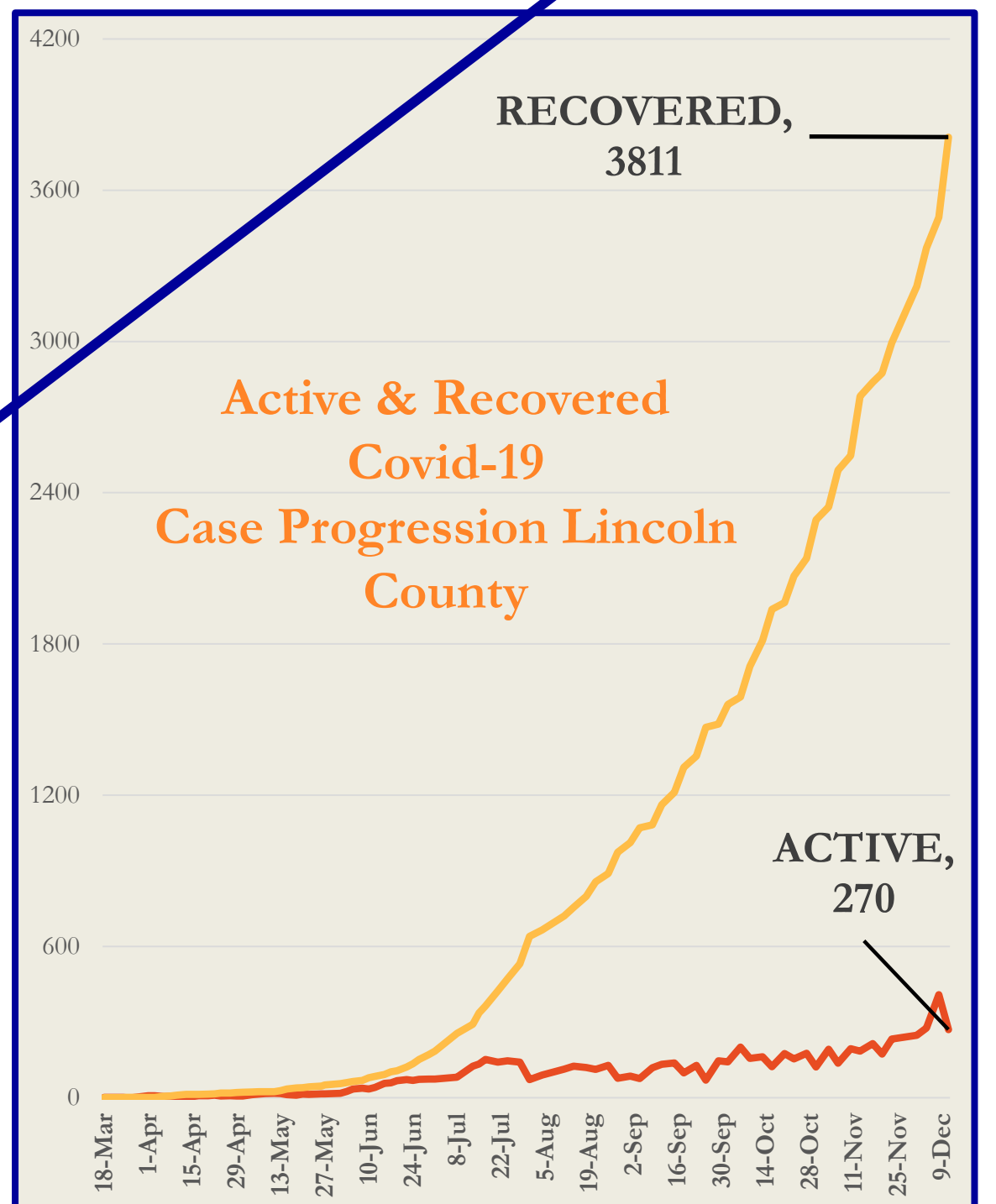


Lincoln County continues to see an unprecedented number of resulted positives across our area. Similarly, this is being seen across the state. Lincoln County currently has an overall percent positive of approximately 13% for the past two weeks. This is a 35% increase in percent positives from our last infographic update. Out of more than 1300 positives in the past 30 days, 15.6% were ages 65+, which is a decrease from the last report, and 13.4% were ages 0-17, a slight increase. Due to the apparent rise in community spread, it is important for everyone to recognize personal responsibility to help control transmission and be cautious.

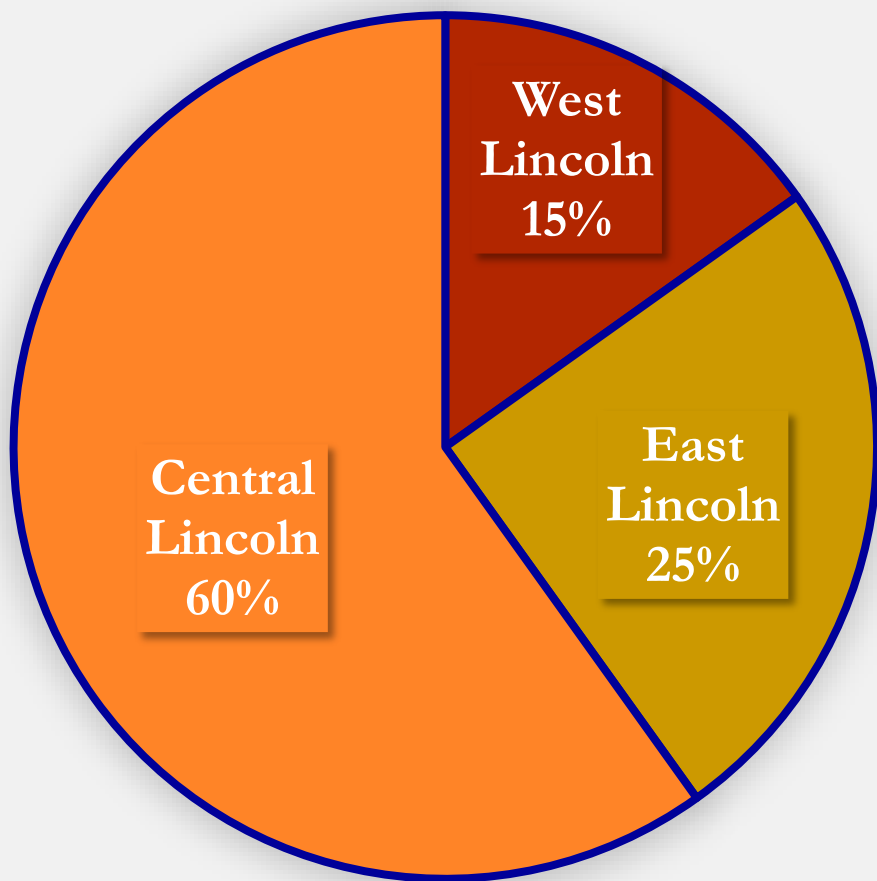


This graph shows the number of active and recovered case counts on a given date over a period of time.

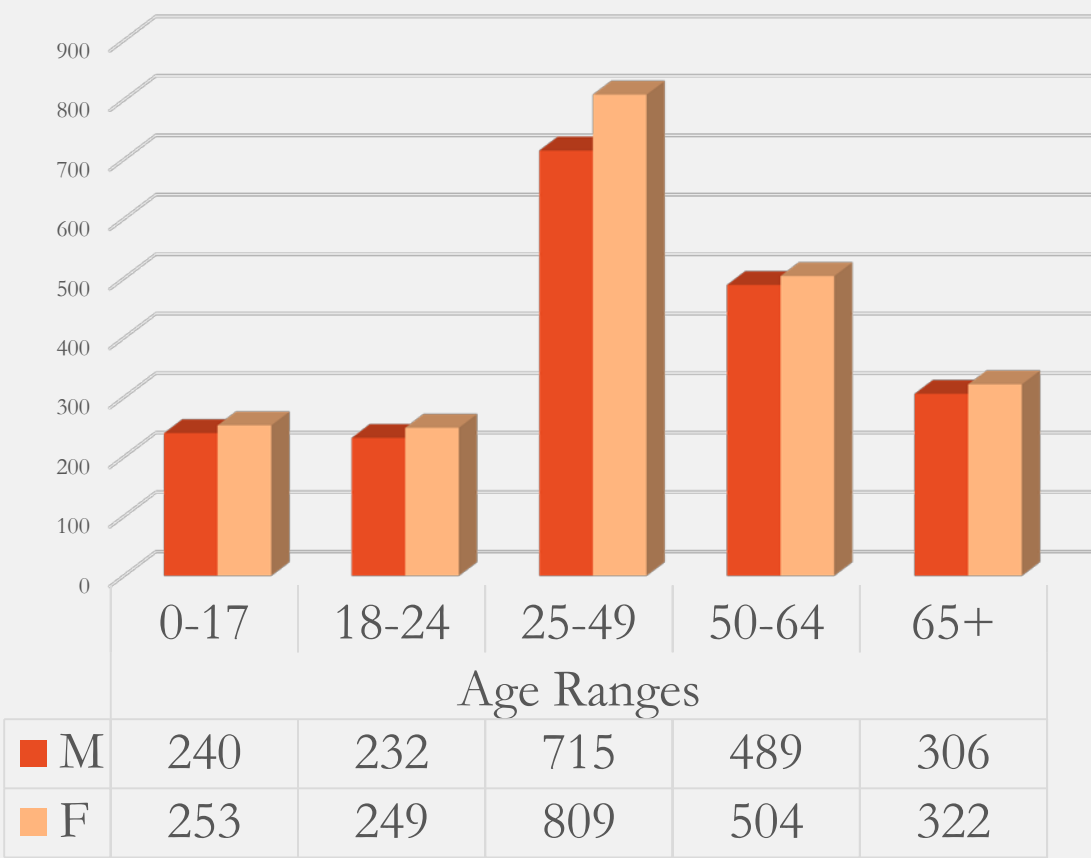

Regional COVID-19 Presence

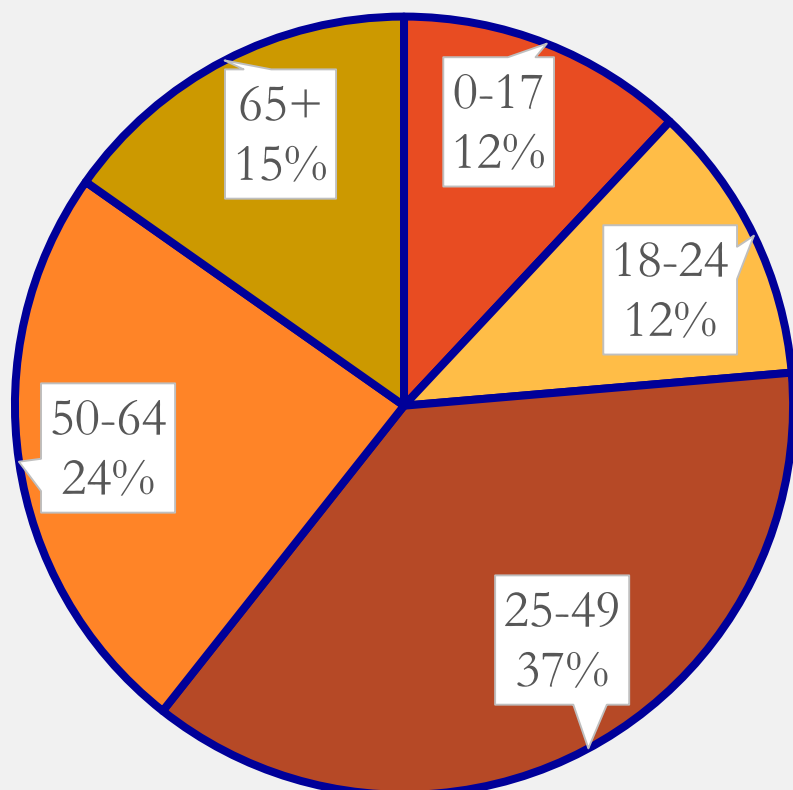
